

2017 Livestock Schedule

Thursday, September 14th

10:00 AM – 2:00 PM:

Weigh market hogs at swine barn scale. Exhibitors must bring quality assurance/health record papers and Check-in required feed.

12:00 PM – 1:00 PM:

Weigh market lambs and goats at beef scale. All Sheep and goat market animal exhibitors must bring quality assurance health record papers.

1:00 PM – 3:00 PM:

Weigh market steers at beef scale. All steer exhibitors must present WA Haul Slip, proper proof of ownership and beef QA form at the time they cross scales. Contact Kayla Slaybaugh with questions. Exhibitors must bring quality assurance/health records papers.

3:00 PM – 3:30 PM:

Weigh late arriving lambs/goats

***Note:** Exhibitors must designate a market sale animal at time of weigh-in by “sale, turn or take-out”.

Friday, September 15th

7:30 AM:

Pens and stalls of animals brought in on Thursday must be clean. **Exhibitors must feed and water their own animals!**

8:00 AM: Poultry and Rabbit Judging

Animals to be shown on Friday must be on the grounds.

8:30 AM:

4-H and FFA Livestock Judging event begins.

10:30 AM: Open Beef Show

Open Beef, Jr. Breeding Classes followed by Senior Open Beef Heifer Classic.

12:00 PM: Swine Show

Swine Show, Open, FFA, 4-H

1:00 PM: Beef Show

Beef Fitting & Showing demonstration with the beef judge, followed by Lil' Pardner's (children under 4-H age), FFA and 4-H Market Steer Confirmation Classes. FFA Market Steer Fitting and Showing followed by 4-H Market Steer Fitting and Showing.

3:00 PM: Sheep and Goat Show

Sheep Show, immediately followed by the Goat Show.

Saturday, September 16th

7:00 AM – 7:30 AM:

Weighing of 4-H & FFA Feeder Steers for show and Rate-of-Gain Contests. All stalls and pens must be clean. **Exhibitors must feed and water their own animals!**

8:15 AM:

Swine Fitting and Showing demonstration with Judge.

8:30 AM: Swine Show

Open class, FFA, followed by 4-H.

9:00 AM:

Beef Fitting and Showing demonstration with judge for feeder steer showman, followed by Lil' Pardners 2nd optional showing.

9:30 AM: Beef Show

FFA and 4-H Feeder Steer Confirmation Classes (alternate beginning with FFA; FFA Champion selected before 4-H Champion).

FFA Feeder Steer Fitting and Showing (FR/Sophomore followed by Junior/Senior); followed by 4-H Fitting and Showing (Seniors, Intermediates and then Juniors).

11:00 AM: Sheep and Goat Show

Lamb Fitting and Showing demonstration with judge.

FFA Fitting and Showing (Freshman/Sophomore, followed by Junior/Senior); followed by 4-H Fitting and Showing Classes (Senior, intermediate, then Junior); followed by Open Fitting and Showing.

Sunday, September 17th

8:00 AM: Horse Show

4-H Horse Show begins in Horse Arena immediately followed by Open Horse and Trail Show.

9:00 AM

All stalls and pens must be cleaned. All exhibitors must feed and water their own animals.

4:00 PM

Fair Ends! All livestock & Horse Exhibitors must clean out their pens and stall areas before leaving the fairgrounds! Check out with your Barn Superintendent!

Note: Premium money may be withheld if animals are not cared for and/or pens/stalls are not cleaned on time each day. This includes being on time for pen duty assigned by Barn Superintendent.
