NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COUNTY ROADS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Garfield County roads are declared closed pursuant to Ordinance #12282 to all vehicular traffic except school buses and emergency vehicles for a period of 180 days beginning November 15 each year.

Violation of this Order of Closure as set forth in this notice constitutes a misdemeanor pursuant RCW 47.48.040 and that persons convicted of violating Ordinance # 12282 by operating a motor vehicle on the below described roads shall be liable to a \$100 fine.

Any person who shall suffer undue hardship as a result of the closure of the below described roads may make application to the Garfield County Board of Commissioners for a permit to use said roads.

ALPOWA CREEK ROAD #295

From M.P. 4.54 at Landkammer residences, west

BALL GRADE ROAD #231

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 3.13 (entire road) from junction of Hutchens Hill Road to Rickman Gulch Road 3.13 miles.

BOSLEY GRADE ROAD #162

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 1.56 (entire road); from junction of Mountain Road to Peola Road.

BOUNDS ROAD #483

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 1.56 (entire road) from junction Kirby-Mayview Road to Tramway Road (1.56 miles).

BROWN GULCH ROAD #215

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 3.18 (entire road): from junction Fairground Road to Mountain Road (3.18 miles).

CHAPEL HILL ROAD #215

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 1.50 (entire road)

COTTON ROAD #427

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 1.21 (complete road).

EAST OLIPHANT RIDGE ROAD #111

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 7.34 (entire road): from Marengo Road to Blind Grade Road (7.34 miles).

EAST WAWAWAI GRADE ROAD #485

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.75 (entire road) from junction Tramway Road to Wawawai Grade Road (0.75 miles).

FITZGERALD ROAD #178

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 3.70 from Peola Road to Iron Springs Road.

FITZGERALD WYE ROAD #131

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.13 (0.13 miles) from Peola Road to Fitzgerald Road.

GIMLIN ROAD #441

From M.P. 1.03 to M.P. 0.00 from Jim Gwinn's north

GEIGER GULCH ROAD #142

From M.P. 1.90 to M.P. 4.61: from City Limits 1.53 miles to one mile West from Skyhawk Hill Road (2.71 miles).

HUTCHENS HILL ROAD #225

From M.P. 4.82 to M.P. 7.75: from Rickman Gulch Road to Bill Patterson residence (2.95 miles).

KIMES ROAD #131

From M.P. 2.74 to M.P. 4.88: from Linville Ridge Road to Tatman Mountain Road (2.06 miles).

KNOTGRASS ROAD #255

From Wolf residence to Alpowa Creek Road Junction.

LINVILLE RIDGE ROAD #10200

From M.P. 6.9 approximately 200' east of Ron Niebel residence to M.P. 10.0 approximately 200' south of Scoggin residence.

MC GRANN HILL ROAD #399

From M.P. 0.91 to M.P. 3.22: from Lee Koller residence to Gould City-Mayview Road (2.31 miles).

MC KEE ROAD #474

From M.P. 1.04 to M.P. 2.75: from 1.04 miles East of Kirby-Mayview Road (1.71 miles): from M.P. 2.95 to M.P. 4.42: from Raines Road to Malone Hill Road (1.47 miles).

NORTH SOUTH NEBUHR ROAD #275

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.64 State Hwy 12 to East West Nebur Road.

PATAHA CREEK SPUR ROAD #166

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.93 (entire road) from junction Pataha Creek Road to Peola Road.

STOREY ROAD #149

From M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.75: from junction Dutch Flat Road to field approach on west side (0.75 miles).

TATMAN MOUNTAIN ROAD #135

From M.P. 2.00 to M.P. 5.36: From 2 miles South of Skyhawk Hill Road to Lewis Road (3.86 miles).

LEGGE ROAD #452

From M.P. 0.21 to M.P. 2.04: From Koller's driveway to Ken Ledgerwood residence (1.83 miles).

WAWAWAI ROAD #425

From M.P. 1.0 to M.P. 1.45: From the Koller house to the dead end at Oldenberg's gate.

RESOLUTION-----

Of Order of the Board of County Commissioners

GARFIELD COUNTY

In the matter of the County Road Load Restrictions Emergency Closing Orders.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the emergency provisions of RCW 36.75.270. all Garfield County Roads are hereby immediately subject to closure for travel by all vehicles exceeding 237 lbs. per inch width of tire for a period of 180 days beginning November 15th each year. Note: the Board may suspend or extend the closure on any county road by independent action according to the prevailing conditions.

1. THIS ORDER shall supersede for the period designated any previous order in conflict herewith, provided that this order shall not supersede or modify any restrictions now in force covering load limits on bridges located upon the above described roads.

The county roads posted with a copy of this notice are closed to all vehicles the gross weight vehicle and load of which exceed the following attached load limits for the size of tires as set forth.

In accordance with RCW 36.75.270. the emergency restrictions attached may be imposed effective immediately, by posting the roads involved.

2. NO ALLOWANCE SHALL BE MADE for any second gear axle suspended from the frame of the vehicle independent of the regular driving axle, otherwise known as "rigid trail" axles. Allowance will be made for single tires only on the front of any truck. The load distribution on any axle of a vehicle shall be such that it will not load the tires on said axles in excess of the prescribed load, as above set forth. Any loading in excess of the specified maximums as listed herein will be considered a violation of this order. If the motive power for any type of trailer is inadequate to safely handle the specified maximum load as listed herein for such a trailer, then in that event, the load on the trailer shall be reduced sufficiently to allow said truck and trailer to operate with safety.

3. VIOLATION-MISDEMEANOR. Any violation of these restrictions constitute a misdemeanor under the provisions of RCW 36.75.270 and RCW 9a.20.020 (3) and shall be punished by fine of not more

that \$500 or not more than 90 days in the county jail. Violators are also subject to civil penalties for the damage caused by such violations.

4. POSTING The county road engineer or road supervisor in and for said Garfield County is delegated the authority in the absence of said Board of County Commissioners and with their permission to close any and all COUNTY ROADS from time to time whenever he deems it necessary to protect and maintain said roads: but that he shall before closing said road post notices of such closing at each end of said road, for the purpose of giving due notice to the public of said closure of road or roads.

The Board of County Commissioners of Garfield County hereby resolves to place the above described Load Restrictions and Emergency Closing Orders in effect beginning November 15th each year for 180 days, and the county road purpose described herein is declared a public necessity and the County Engineer shall be and is hereby ordered and authorized to proceed as prescribed by law.
