<b>By 7 Years or Kindergarten</b>	3 doses	5 doses	Not given after 5 years of age unless child has medical condition	4 doses	Not given after 5 years of age unless child has medical condition	2 doses	2 doses OR Healthcare provider verified child had disease

## Required Immunizations for School Year 2018-2019

<b>6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade</b>	<b>3 doses <i>within the correct timeframes</i></b>	<b>5 doses DTaP  AND  1 dose Tdap, all within the correct timeframes</b>	<b>4 doses <i>within the correct timeframes</i></b>	<b>2 doses <i>within the correct timeframes</i></b>	<b>2 doses <i>within the correct timeframes</i> OR Healthcare provider verified child had disease <i>(Exceptions are allowed for certain students)</i></b>

- **Students must get vaccine doses at correct timeframes to be in compliance with the requirements. Talk to your healthcare provider or school staff if you have questions about school immunization requirements.**
